Pricing	
① Composting & Worms	Residents = \$40 per person / Non-residents = \$60 per person / Child = \$10 per child. Residents Family = \$60 per family**.
② Composting with Kids	Residents Children = \$20 per child / Non-residents Children = \$25 per child.
③ Supporting School & Community Composts	Residents = \$30 per person / Non-residents = \$50 per person / Child 5-18 years old = \$10 per child. Child under 5 years old = no charge. <i>Bookings of 3 or more adult tickets together are discounted to \$20 per person (residents) and \$40 per person (non-residents).</i>
④ General Workshops	Residents = \$40 per person / Non-residents = \$60 per person.
⑤ Educators Professional Development Day	Educator based at school/centre located within Northern Beaches Council and Mosman Council areas = \$125 per person. Educator based at school/centre located out of the above Council areas = \$150 per person.

Residents	Adult attendees residing within Northern Beaches Council and Mosman Council areas.
Non-residents	Adult attendees residing out of the above Council areas.
Child	Primary school age up to 18 years.
**Residents Family	Composting & Worms Workshop only. Families residing within the Northern Beaches Council and Mosman Council areas (ticket includes 2 adults & up to 3 children aged 5-18 years).

***Northern Beaches Residents attending the whole Composting & Worms workshop:** Northern Beaches Council would like to support its residents in recycling food waste at home by giving you a voucher towards buying a worm farm or compost bin. Northern Beaches Council will issue a \$90 voucher to Northern Beaches residents who attend a Kimbriki Composting and Worms workshop, and **who have not had a free worm farm, compost bin or voucher from Council in the past.** One voucher per household (not per person) is issued irrespective of number of workshops attended. The vouchers are issued directly from Council after you have attended the workshop. Please allow up to 3-4 weeks for the voucher to be issued and posted to your residential address. Voucher can be used at New Leaf Nursery in Ingleside or at the Kimbriki Eco House & Garden Eco shop.
