Northern Beaches Council will issue a \$90 voucher to Northern Beaches residents who attend a Kimbriki Composting and Worms workshop, and **who have not had a free worm farm, compost bin or voucher from Council in the past**. One voucher per household (not per person) is issued irrespective of number of workshops attended. The vouchers are issued directly from Council after you have attended the workshop. Please allow up to 3-4 weeks for the voucher to be issued and posted to your residential address. Voucher can be used at New Leaf Nursery in Ingleside or at the Kimbriki Eco House & Garden Eco shop.
